ABOUT TORONTO

Toronto is one of the most multicultural cities in the world. It is home to more than 100 cultures. Toronto is Canada's largest city, with a population of 5 million, and is 5th largest city in North America, after Mexico City, New York, Los Angeles and Chicago. One-quarter of Canada's population is located within 160 km (100 mi.) of Toronto. More than 60% of the population of the USA is within a 90-minute flight of Toronto.

As the capital of Ontario, it is the seat of government for Canada's most populous province and is the industrial and business center for the country. There are two official languages in Canada – English and French. In addition to these official languages, the top 5 languages spoken in Toronto are Chinese, Italian, Tamil, Portuguese and Spanish.



ABOUT GEOS TORONTO

GEOS Language Academy is located in the heart of downtown Toronto, in the “Old Town Toronto” district near the corner of Adelaide and Church Streets. We are located a few short blocks from King Subway Station, and streetcars are just a few minutes walk from the school.

All GEOS instructors are native English speakers and are highly skilled, caring professionals. Our staff is specially trained to work with international students and we pride ourselves on the high level of personal attention we give to each student. Toronto offers students the opportunity to study in a multicultural, urban environment with nature and the countryside within easy reach.

At school, students from all over the world study year round in our Comprehensive English Program (CEP). We also offer a variety of elective and specialty programs such as Working Holiday Preparation Course, Internship Program, Writing and Pronunciation courses, and FREE Volunteer Program.

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM (IE) - 24 lessons/week

Integrated Skills Class (AM)

During the Integrated Skills Class, students study four English skills - reading, writing, speaking, and listening - in an interactive way through a system called Communicative Language Teaching. Students use various activities to practice English conversation including listening tasks, role plays, and discussion. Practical reading and writing tasks and vocabulary studies are presented as well.

Active Listening Class (PM)

During the Active Listening class, students will cover a variety of topics while practicing English conversation management, North American conversational styles, and pronunciation. Students learn commonly used North American idioms and slang in a communicative way. Students use various activities to practice these new idioms including listening tasks, role plays, and discussion.

SUPER INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM (SIE) - 31 lessons/week

The Intensive Program is ideal for students who wish to improve faster and study more seriously by adding an elective course to the CEP. Elective courses are delivered Monday to Thursday, immediately after the CEP program, so students get a full day of instruction. GEOS understands that different students need to work on different skills and so there are several options for intensive study depending on the students' level. Please note that new elective courses are added based on student demand so check with GEOS often for the latest information.

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

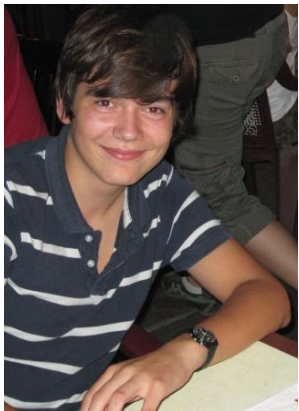

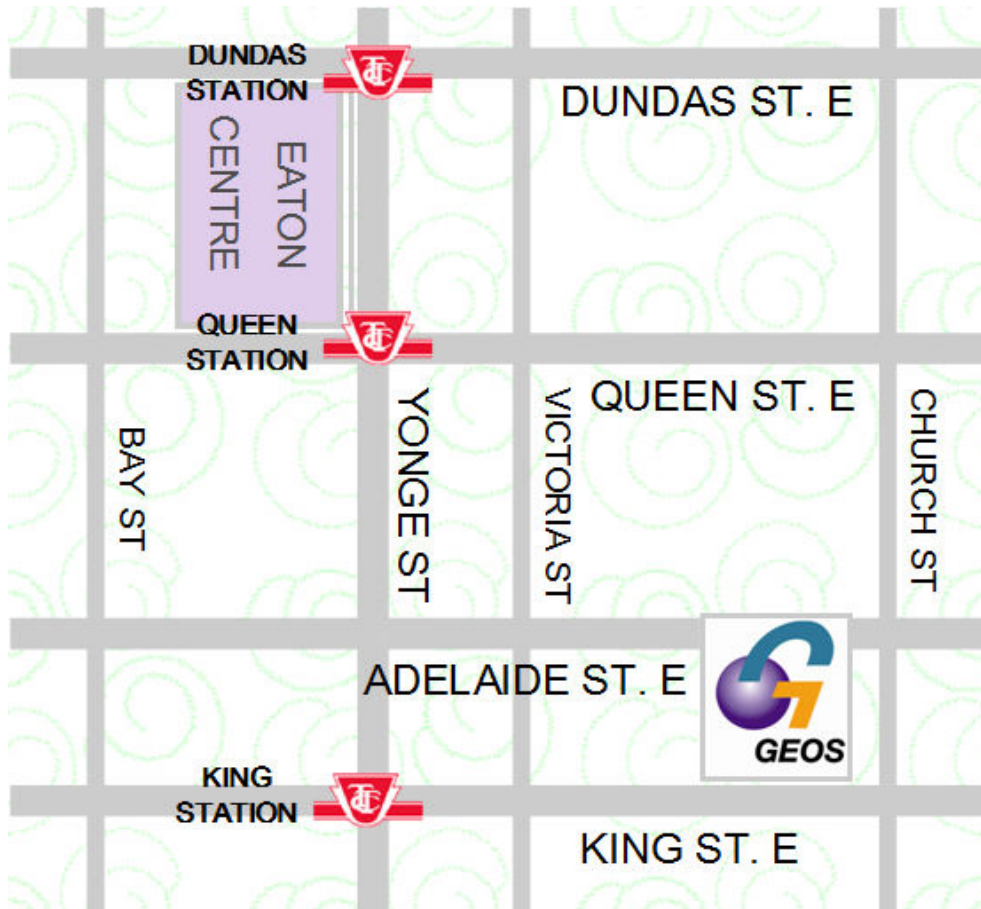
CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO 2011 FEES
