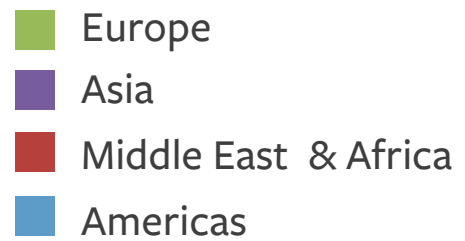
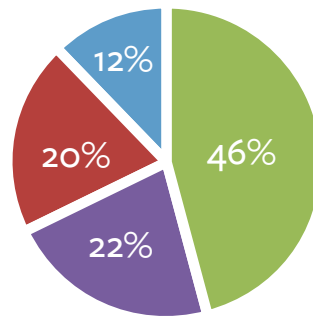

2 Year MSc in Finance Programme

Students who apply for the 2 Year MSc in Finance aspire to boost their existing careers in the financial sector, in such areas as investment and commercial banking, asset management, financial services and consulting, or with corporate finance positions within international organisations. A high level of commitment is required from applicants as this programme is only offered on a full-time basis.

Successful applicants will study towards a 2 Year MSc in Finance from the triple-accredited institution, Grenoble Graduate School of Business. Triple accreditation is an honour shared by less than 1% of the world's elite business schools.

Documents

- Completed online application form
- Certified copies of relevant certificates/transcripts
- Copy of passport
- CV / résumé in English
- 3 essays (500 words each) focusing on your academic and professional experience
- 2 letters of recommendation (Employer or Academic)

Qualifications

- Strong undergraduate degree from a recognised university (assessed by GGSB admission board)
- GMAT is not an obligatory requirement, but is considered an advantage and may be required for some applications. Target score over 550

Proof of English proficiency

- TOEFL - 94 (minimum: L-21, R-22, S-23, W-21)
- IELTS - 6.5 (6.0 minimum in each component)
- PTE - 63 (51 minimum in each component)

- Work experience is not an obligatory requirement, but is considered an advantage
