Milner School of English is in the centre of Wimbledon...

Wimbledon station is 600 metres from the school, **South Wimbledon station** is also 600 metres away and buses stop near the school's front door.

The **Centre Court** shopping centre, **Odeon cinema complex**, the **YMCA sports centre and gym** and **Wimbledon swimming pool** are all nearby in the Broadway.

Milner School is surrounded by shops and cafés and Wimbledon's pleasant residential areas are within walking distance.

Wimbledon Common (woodlands) and **The All England Tennis Club** are also within walking distance of the school.

Our Premises and Facilities

- **17 centrally heated classrooms** and spacious student lounge, all light and airy with wall to wall carpets and comfortable furniture.
- A **library and self-access** room with a good supply of books, DVDs and magazines for individual study at home or school.
- A computer room with **free email and internet. Wi-fi** access throughout the school.
- **Café** serving home made food and hot and cold drinks every morning and lunchtime.
- **Free** daily supply of **newspapers and popular magazines** in the student lounge.



The Teachers

All the teachers at Milner School are experienced professionals properly trained to teach English as a foreign language. They all speak English as their first language and have been chosen for their ability to work together as a team and relate well to young adults. Most have taught English abroad and between them speak a variety of languages.

The Courses

The courses have been devised to satisfy the requirements of people who need English for a better job, who wish to feel confident in using English for business and international communication or who just want to enjoy the experience of living and learning in Britain.

Lessons are well structured and teaching combines the best of new and traditional language teaching methodology:

- Grammatical structure
- Functions
- Vocabulary
- Communicative situations
- Accuracy and fluency
- Pronunciation

At all levels, speaking, listening, writing and reading skills are integrated to develop a complete command of English.

Grading and Classes

On the first day, each student's English is assessed by means of written and spoken tests. He or she is then placed in a class of appropriate level. The progress of each student is monitored, and transfers between levels are made as required and without delay.

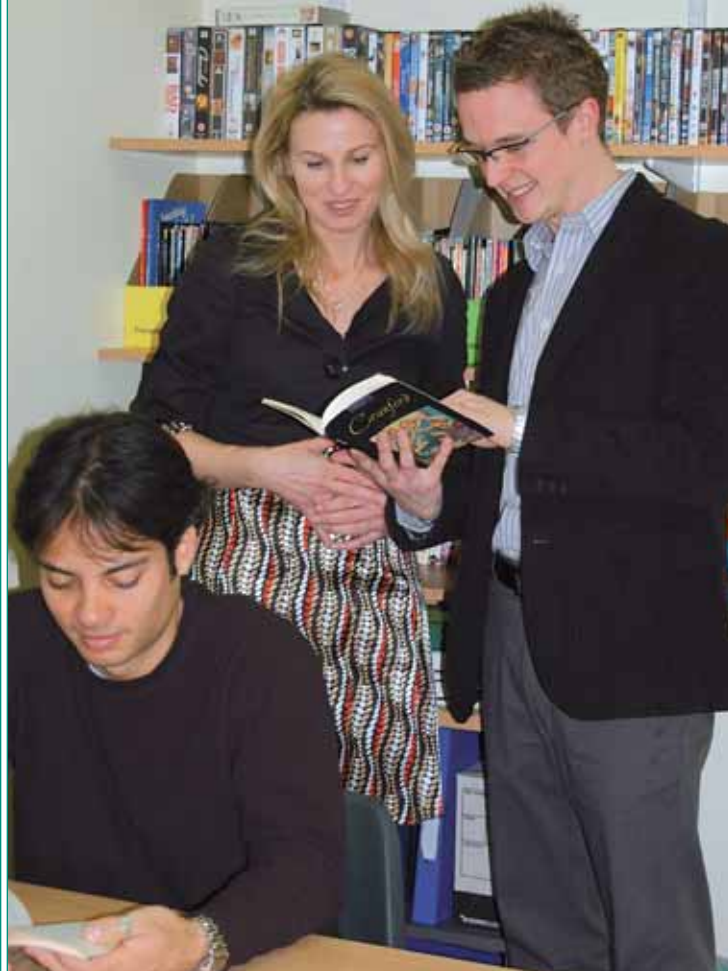

Most of our students range in age from **18 to 25** years. The average age is **23**. The minimum age for enrolment is **16**. There is no maximum age.

We can accept groups, minimum age 16, at certain times of year.

The classes are multinational with a **maximum of 12** students per class.

Accommodation & Welfare

- Day trips to other towns such as Oxford, Cambridge or Brighton.

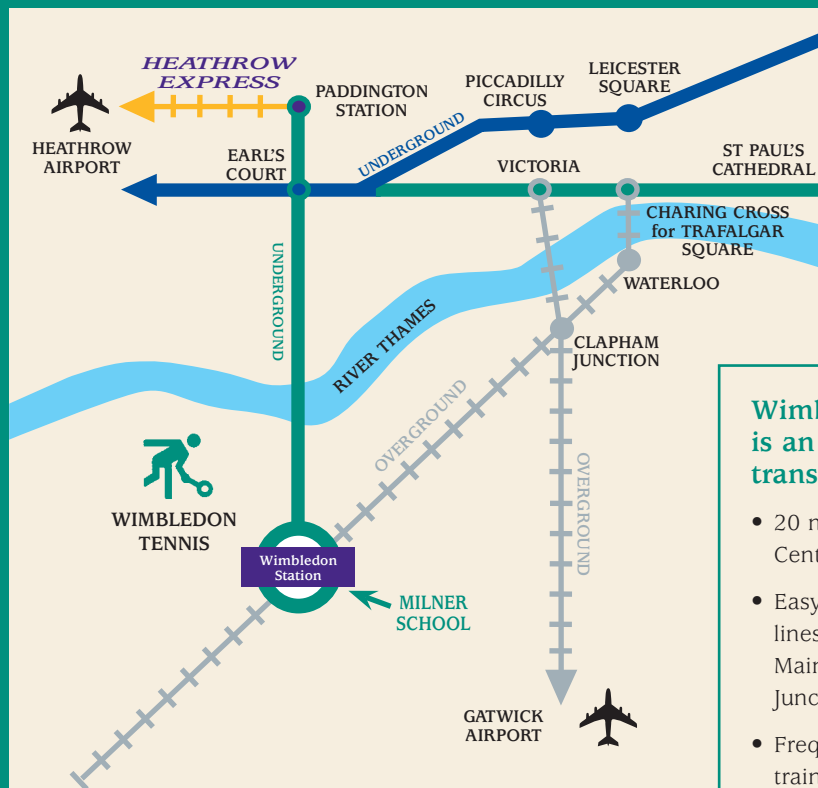
Some trips are run by the school; others by reputable tour operators. Costs are shown on our website.
