LOCATION

The Tasmanian College of English (SACE Hobart) is located in Hobart, Tasmania and is a 10 minute walk from the city centre, Mall and the Café precinct of Salamanca Place and the city wharf area.

Hobart, Tasmania

- Tasmania is Australia's wilderness state and eco-tourism capital.
- Hobart is the capital city of Tasmania and has a population of 200,000 people.

GETTING HERE

Qantas, Jetstar and Virgin Blue offer direct flights from most mainland capital cities. Many other flights connect via Sydney, Brisbane or Melbourne.

The Hobart Airport is located 20 minutes by car from the city centre.

CLIMATE

Hobart enjoys a mild climate, with four distinct seasons. The average maximum temperature in summer (December to February) is 23°C to 26°C and in winter (June to August) 12°C—15°C.

TRANSPORT

Students are issued with a student card which entitles them to receive a discount on the City Bus Service.

WORKING IN HOBART

There are some work opportunities during the summer months in the Hospitality Industry and picking fruits in the regional areas of Tasmania.

VOLUNTEERING IN TASMANIA

SACE Hobart offers an English and Volunteering Programme which gives students a unique insight into Tasmania's wilderness areas and conservation projects.
